
Age & sex

- 26.5 percent of people are aged under 15 years in Grenada North, compared with 20.6 percent for all of Wellington Region.


Age Group and Sex

Birthplace

- 24.1 percent of people in Grenada North were born overseas, compared with 23.3 percent for Wellington Region as a whole.
- For people born overseas who are now living in Grenada North, the most common birthplace was the Pacific Islands, compared with the UK and Ireland for all of Wellington Region.

Languages spoken

- English is the most commonly spoken language in Grenada North.
- 8.0 percent of people in Grenada North speak Māori, compared with 3.6 percent of people for all of Wellington Region.
- New Zealand Sign Language is used by 0.9 percent of people in Grenada North, compared with 0.6 percent of people for all of Wellington Region.
- 67.0 percent of people in Grenada North speak only one language, compared with 79.0 percent of people for all of Wellington Region.


Marital status

Total population aged 15 years and over

- 38.7 percent of people aged 15 years and over living in Grenada North have never married, 45.3 percent are married, and 14.7 percent are separated, divorced or widowed.
- 32.1 percent of people aged 15 years and over in Grenada North who have never married, live with a partner.


Education

Total population aged 15 years and over

- 30.1 percent of people aged 15 years and over in Grenada North have a post-school qualification, compared with 46.3 percent of people throughout Wellington Region.
- In Grenada North, 34.2 percent of people aged 15 years and over have no formal qualifications, compared with 19.8 percent for Wellington Region as a whole.


Work

Total population aged 15 years and over

- The unemployment rate in Grenada North is 8.2 percent for people aged 15 years and over, compared with 5.2 percent for all of Wellington Region.
- The most common occupational group in Grenada North is 'Technicians and trades workers' and 'Professionals' is the most common occupational group in Wellington Region.


Income

Total population aged 15 years and over

- For people aged 15 years and over, the median income (half earn more, and half less, than this amount) in Grenada North is \$29,300. This compares with a median of \$28,000 for all of Wellington Region.
- 33.8 percent of people aged 15 years and over in Grenada North have an annual income of \$20,000 or less, compared with 38.8 percent of people for Wellington Region as a whole.
- In Grenada North, 13.5 percent of people aged 15 years and over have an annual income of more than \$50,000, compared with 23.6 percent of people in Wellington Region.

Families

- Couples with children make up 46.7 percent of all families in Grenada North, while couples without children make up 30.0 percent of all families.
- In Wellington Region, couples with children make up 42.4 percent of all families, while couples without children make up 40.0 percent of all families.
- 23.3 percent of families in Grenada North are one-parent-with-children families, compared with 17.6 percent of families for Wellington Region as a whole.


Grenada North

Households

- One-family households make up 76.5 percent of all households in Grenada North. For Wellington Region as a whole, one-family households make up 66.9 percent of all households.
- 12 people (or 11.8 percent) live in one-person households in Grenada North. Throughout Wellington Region, one-person households make up 24.7 percent of all households.
- The average household size in Grenada North is 3.1 people, compared with an average of 2.6 people for all of Wellington Region.

Phones, net & fax

Households

- 61.8 percent of households in Grenada North have access to the Internet, compared with 65.5 percent of households throughout Wellington Region.
- In Grenada North 82.4 percent of households have access to a cellphone, compared with 76.3 percent of households for Wellington Region as a whole.




Transport


Grenada North
