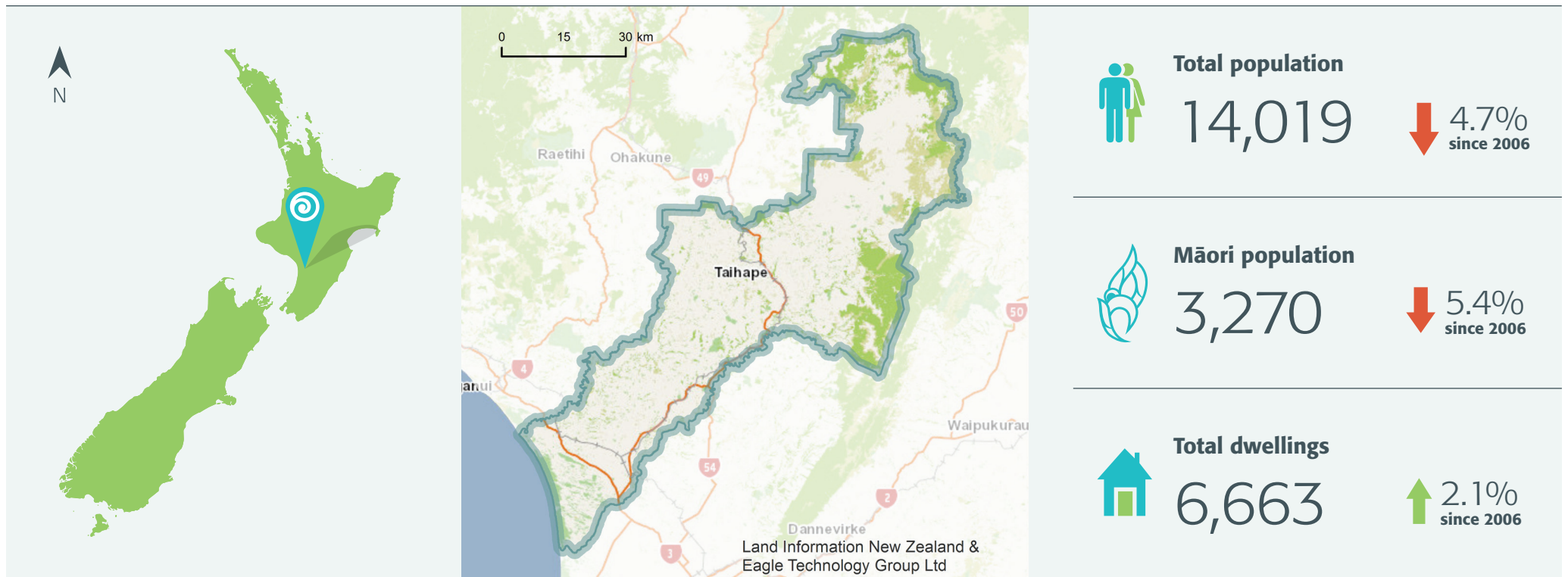
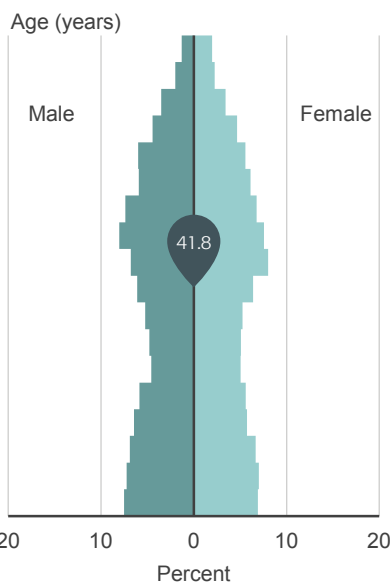


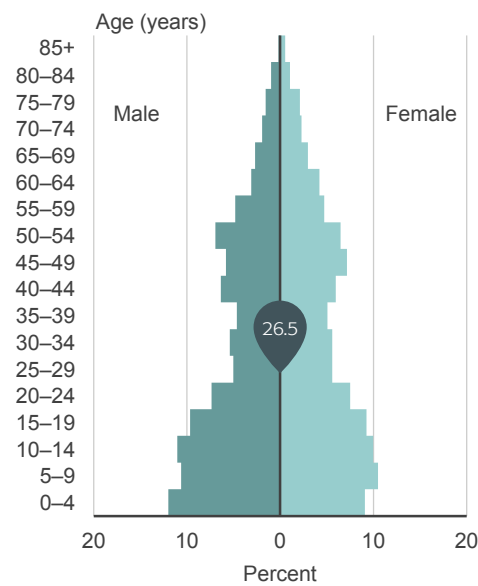

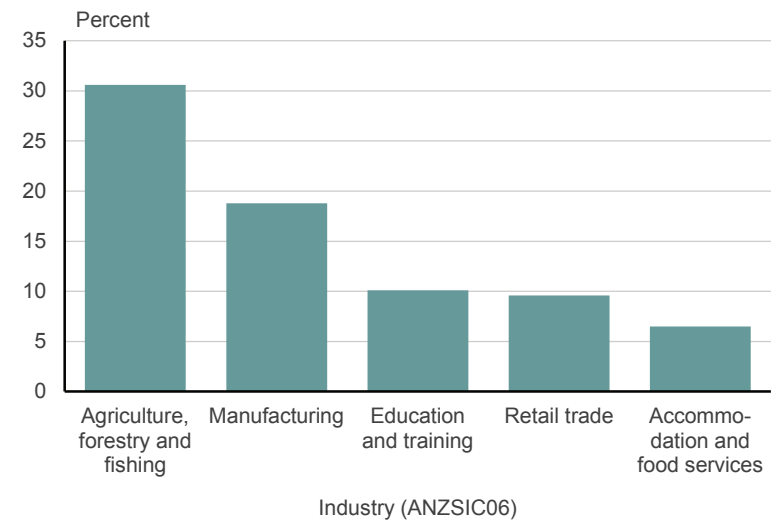
Age and sex of people
